

## Meeting on Agriculture

The NGOs who are planning to play videos in the stalls were asked to bring additional copies of the same to present to the participants in case of demand. NGOs like CCD and KUDUMBAM were asked to exhibit part of their works considering their long standing in the field. The NGOs who did not attend the day's meeting, yet confirmed stalls in the previous meeting, would be followed up to confirm their presence in the stalls. The stalls for the exhibition would be made ready by 6 pm on 2nd August for NGOs to actually go and place their materials. Displaying quality materials in the stalls was re-emphasised.

All the NGOs were asked to send the revised figures for the following works they did in Nagapattinam following the tsunami:

- Total number of revenue villages covered
- Total number of hamlets covered
- Total land/area covered
- Total number of farmers covered

- Total number of farm ponds covered
- Irrigation channels covered – number and length
- Drainage channels covered – number and length
- Total number of common ponds covered

All the NGOs were asked to submit the above details by noon on or before 01st August. It is reiterated that one person inside the workshop hall and a couple for the stalls from each NGO can be sent. However, the number of persons inside the stall could be more.
