IEC's dissemination:

- The technical linkage, transformation of a particular information is extremely high. So it was really helpful in disseminating the Tsunami related information throughout the District
- RTI- Right to information act. (Posters and notices, conducted RTI camps.)
- On Panchayats election awareness. (Posters and notices)
- Chikunkuniya disease control messages were printed and disseminated to the people on right time and Clusters have played a major role in controlling the diseases..
- ADB Schemes awareness spread and few other guidance's related to proposal writing also done.

Networking:
